Program Options

EXPERIENCE PROGRAM This introductory weekend program teaches participants how to stay warm and have fun outdoors in the winter. Learn how to use the winter camping gear and ease into winter survival skills. Develop outdoor winter skills, teambuilding, cross country skiing, winter nature, snowshoeing, play broomball, and engage in initiative games.

Sleeping Accommodations: Sleep inside Friday night (Snow Base Only) and Saturday night. Sleeping outside Saturday near the bunkhouse is optional. **Cost:** \$88 (Snow Base), \$81 (North Wind) per participant (includes gear, food, lodging, staff, and activities)



Sleeping Accommodations: Sleep inside Friday night and outside Saturday night. Everyone in your group should expect to sleep outside.

Cost: \$101 per participant (includes gear, food, lodging, staff, and activities)

ICE FISHING Staff-guided Ice Fishing experience. Scouts have the opportunity to earn the fishing merit badge while learning from MN's experienced ice anglers. Scouts will be outfitted with the latest fishing gear used by the pros, as well as winter gear to stay warm outside.

Sleeping Accommodations: This is a Saturday only program. Option to spend Saturday night indoors or outdoors for extra charge.

Cost: \$81 per participant (includes gear, food, staff, and activities)

SEARCH & RESCUE This specialty program designed to connect Scouts with Search and Rescue professionals to learn how to save a life! Scouts will be outfitted with warm winter gear. Scouts have a chance to earn the Search and Rescue merit badge while learning how to help save lives.

Sleeping Accommodations: This is a Saturday only program. Option to spend Saturday night indoors or outdoors for extra charge.

Cost: \$81 per participant (includes gear, food, lodging, staff, and activities)

DOG SLEDDING This specialty program designed to teach Scouts about dog sledding. Scouts harness, feed/care for dogs. Scouts drive and ride sleds. Registration for this program is by lottery. Lottery opens September 15th. Must have camped at Snow Base or North Wind to be considered for participation.

Sleeping Accommodations: Sleep inside Friday night and Saturday night. Sleeping outside Saturday near bunkhouse is optional.

Cost: \$269 per Scout. \$88 per adult (adults don't ride)
